GENERAL SALARY INCREASE

R12 and U12 (Rank-and-File Ranges)

CLASSES

Effective January 1, 2017, in compliance with an agreement between the State of California and Bargaining Unit (BU) 12, CalHR approved a 3.5-percent General Salary Increase. All <u>classes</u> designated R12 and rank-and-file ranges in U12 shall be increased by 3.5 percent.
