Effective July 1, 2021, CalHR approved Special Salary Adjustments for the classes identified below.

EMPLOYEES

Effective July 1, 2021, all employees designated S01 in the classes identified below shall receive the Special Salary Adjustment, including employees who separated from state service prior to July 1, 2021, and have lump sum payments that extend beyond July 1, 2021. The lump sum payments shall be adjusted to reflect the salary increase below.

Departments will need to submit a STD. 674 A/R to adjust applicable payments issued 7/1/2021 or after. Also, correct any resulting out-of-sequence transactions.
